

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

Reservation and deposit - For the tour a booking deposit is required at the time of registration. The deposit is \$1000 US per person. This deposit secures a space on the tour. Space is limited and reservations are on a first come first serve basis. The balance is due 90 days before the start of the tour.

Submitting a registration form does not confirm availability nor participation on a tour.

Cancellation Policy - Greek Adventures recommends all participants purchase travel insurance on their trip.

Greek Adventures is not responsible for a participant's inability to attend a tour due to any circumstance whether they be health, family or environmental.

If a tour is canceled by Greek Adventures ahead of departure due to lack of participation all deposits and balance payments are 100% transferable and refundable.

Cancellations initiated by the participant received in writing with more than 60 days notice before tour start date will receive their \$1,000 USD deposit as a credit to be used towards future tours with Greek Adventures. The credit expires 2 years after issued.

Cancellations initiated by the participant received in writing with 60 days or less notice before the tour start date will forfeit their deposit as a cancellation fee. Any balance payments can be held on file as a credit to be used towards future tours with Greek Adventures. The Credit expires 2 years after issued.

Cancellations initiated by the participant received in writing to [vas2grny@mac.com](mailto:vas2grny@mac.com) with 30 days or less notice before the tour start date will forfeit their deposit and any balance payments as a cancellation fee.

Greek Adventures reserves the right to cancel a participants tour during the tour if the participant is disruptive or putting themselves or others in harms way. No refund or credit will be issued.

Responsibility - Greek Adventures is responsible for providing the services in the tour description according to the local standard and the accurate description of services offered in its literature. GA carefully selects and constantly monitors its contractors, such as hotels and restaurants. GA is responsible for conscientious travel preparations. GA is not responsible or liable for accidents. GA reserves the right, without prior notice, to withdraw any part or all of a tour, to make such changes as may be necessary and the extra cost, if applicable, resulting therefrom, shall be paid by the customer. Furthermore, it is agreed and understood that the owners, operators and agents of this tour, including GA are not the guardians of any customer's safety and they, individually or collectively, cannot be held liable in any way for any occurrence in connection with the operation or the client's participation in connection with the tour, which might result in injury, death, or other damage to the client, his property, or his family, heirs, or assigns. The liability of GA as the tour operator is limited to a total of three times the tour price irrespective of the title/ claim. GA is not responsible for any delays, changes, in schedule or other conditions.

Alterations to tour schedule - Tours operate on a seasonal basis and where seasonal variances and/or weather condition cause changes in the tour routing and accommodations, the itinerary will be adjusted accordingly and alternate hotels, restaurants and roads will be used to maintain everyones safety.

Tour rates - These are calculated on the basis of exchange rates in effect at the time of printing and on tariffs and are subject to change depending on international currency fluctuations and inflation and may be adjusted by GA upon receipt of final payment 90 days prior to tour start.
